**Potential Projects:**

- Installation of pet waste stations throughout the neighborhood
- Refurbish and upgrade Floral Park entryway monuments
- Proceed with achieving Historic District designation
- Neighborhood beautification projects
- Continue reforestation in-fill and upgrade size of replacement trees
- Restoration of the vintage streetlights to the original 1930 design, affixing decorative crowns to the globes
- Add a scholarship specifically designated for a Floral Park high school or college student
- Sponsor a student at The Wooden Floor (aka St. Joseph Ballet)
- Charitable work project outside of Floral Park
- Select one specific non-profit organization for sponsorship rather than smaller donations to several non-profits
- Establish a Neighbor-Helping-Neighbor program
- Establish a free library cupboard in Sarah May Downie Herb Garden where neighbors can donate, lend and borrow books
