Summary of Beautification Committee for 2025

1. Regular and consistent maintenance of the exit, entrance and Sarah Mae Downie/Butterfly Garden.
 - a. Includes working with city regarding sprinklers, acceptable plant selections, and repairs.
 - b. The park has been used for the National Historic Designation party.
 - c. A tree lighting celebration was also in the park to mark the beginning of the holidays.
 - d. A park bench lottery was held for the last place for a bench.
 - e. The sprinkler box at SMD/Butterfly Park was installed.
2. The tree committee continues to report dead trees, works with the arborists for replacements and arranges trimming.
3. For 2 years the Curb Appeal Committee has selected homes monthly from the north and south of Santa Clara.
 - a. A handwritten thank you note goes to each homeowner.
 - b. Additionally, a description of each yard has been posted in the newsletter and on Instagram.
4. A new, objective point-based system for selecting the Santa Ana Most Beautiful Yard of the Year Award was developed.
5. Cal Trans removed the ivy on the Broadway off ramp with the help of Jesse Lopez and County of Orange Public Works
 - a. New trees and shrubs were planted at the cul de sac of North Park and Broadway.
6. Meetings were organized regarding the Santa Ana Mainsteam Project.

Proposed Projects for 2026

1. All standing committees will remain.
2. A "Birthday Recognition/Celebration for Homes turning 100" committee - Chris Rosas, Chair, committee members include Julye Bidmead, Paul Gulino, Carmen Davis, Diana Christoffersen and David Buster.
 - a. This committee may be placed under Historic District.
3. Joe Rodriguez volunteered to research appealing trash cans to be distributed in the neighborhood to reduce the amount of trash in our streets and medians.
4. Volunteers will paint lampposts before home tour.
5. Parks and Recreation will be contacted to assist in replacing the DG (decomposed granite walkways) in SMD park, preferably before the Legacy Walk is re-installed.
