- Sarah Mae Downie Park/Butterfly Garden – Beth Hoffman
 - Beautification of SMD Park coordinated trimming of eleven Crepe Myrtle trees during January dormancy.
 - Wednesday Weed Whackers worked in SMD Park on 1st Wednesday in January.
 - CoSA Parks department will assist with trimming boxwood hedges during February.
 - Early in March Cosa will remove and re-install new (DG) Decomposed Granite surface of SMD Park. Details to follow in next Board report.

- Exits and Entrances - Beth Hoffman
 - Beautification team worked @ Santa Clara and Broadway to clean up trash/weeds, roses were trimmed for winter dormancy.
 - New plantings TBD in early Spring 2026.

- Palm Trees on Ross Street – A mature palm fell across Ross Street in January because of Santa Ana Winds.
 - Beautification contacted CoSA Assistant Director of Public Works Mr. Rudy Rosas who authorized CoSA street tree crew to inspect all remaining palm trees on Ross Street. On February 3rd, Mr. Rosas notified us that two palm trees (2003 Ross St. and 2115 N. Ross St.) will be removed during the week of February 2nd, 2026. Street Tree Manager Frank Torres shared that new Crepe Myrtle Trees will be re-planted by CoSA, no new palm trees will be replaced.
